Americas pass - Change Management

Changes to the pass (Reroute / Reissue / Revalidation) = USD 30

REISSUE AND REVALIDATION

Before Departure:

- 1) If changes are being made only to the International sectors before departure and the ticket is completely unutilized, then the entire ticket will have to be reassessed to current fares and the re-issue fee of the International ticket applies
- 2) If changes are made only to the pass sectors before departure and the ticket is completely unutilized, then the International fare does not have to be reassessed and only the re-issue fee of the pass fare applies

After Departure:

- 1) If changes are made only to the pass sectors after departure from the international origin – Only the reissue fee of the pass applies
- 2) If changes are made only to the International sectors after departure from the first origin – Only the reissue fee of the International fares applies
- 3) If changes are made to both International & pass sectors – Most restrictive reissue fee applies

REFUND AND CANCELLATION

Please refer to the international fare rules available in the GDS for full details. Most restrictive fare rule applies

- 1) If the ticket is partially used, the fare must be calculated based on the flown sectors, and the applicable fee is based on the international fare component
- 2) The pass sectors are to be refunded without any change to the International fare component, then a charge of USD 50 will apply per sector. In case of no-show, the no-show sector is non-refundable
- 3) In case of half round trip combination of the international ticket where one fare component is refundable and other is non-refundable, apply refund rule based on the fare component of the journey utilized
- 4) In case of completely unutilised ticket refund rules based on the most restrictive fare component applies

Americas pass - FAQs

1. Can agents sell the Americas pass?

Yes, but can only be sold in conjunction with an Emirates International ticket for travel into the United States

2. Is the pass fare commissionable?

No

3. Can it be issued as a separate ticket?

No

4. Can it be combined with all Fares?

The pass can be combined with all international market fares in all cabins, however no discount applies, and is not applicable for Group quotes

5. Can it be combined with Business and First Class Fares?

Yes, refer to point '4' above, although travel on the pass sectors within the USA will be in economy cabin

6. Can it be combined with Interline Fares?

Yes, provided all conditions of all fare components are met

7. How does it impact the rule conditions of international ticket when combined with the America pass?

Rule conditions of international ticket will remain unchanged

8. Can it be issued with Skywards redemption tickets?

No

9. Is the pass ticket eligible to earn Skywards miles?

Miles can be earned on EK, AS, B6, VX, PD and WS sectors and mileage will be allocated as per the international fare used

10. Can it be used on any other airline?

It is valid for travel on EK flights operated by B6, B6 flights operated by B6 or VX flights operated by VX or AS flights operated by AS, WS flights operated by WS, or PD flights operated by PD

11. Can it be combined with AD/ID tickets?

No

12. How many sectors can be used on a single ticket?

Minimum two sectors, maximum unlimited. However entire journey must be completed within the maximum stay validity of the international fare component

13. Would pass allow surface sector?

Yes, open-jaw is permitted. E.g. BOS-MCO//JFK-SYR permitted

14. Can it be purchased after international ticket has been issued?

Yes; refer to reissue policy above in change management

15. Can it be used with an Open Jaw between America and any other country?

Yes

16. Are the fare levels inclusive of taxes?

No, taxes and surcharge for each sector are to be collected as applicable

17. Is Chauffeur Drive Service available for pax holding F/J cabin EK international fares?

Not eligible for the pass sectors themselves, however for the EK international gateway arrival / departure points will be governed by the International fare eligibility

Americas pass - Booking and Ticketing Procedures

- The RBD to be booked, is dependent on the marketing carrier, e.g. if booking an EK marketed flight operated by B6, book the specified EK RBD, if booking an AS flight operated by AS book the specified AS RBD.
- EK codeshare flights operated by B6, can only be booked in conjunction with an international connecting flight, when booking as a domestic sector book on the B6 flight number.
- **EK Fare Basis Code** – America pass Fare Basis to be shown only on the domestic sector, on the international sectors, show the Fare Basis of the International sectors
